TRC/OPCOTE

The Group believed that this approach would enable them to establish goals and make recommendations to Provincial Council in response to the Calls for Actions in the Truth & Reconciliation Commission's Report.

CEMETERIES

Harry Huskins reported work is continuing to be done on problems concerning cemeteries and burial grounds, forensic archaeology, and their regulation by the provincial government. Dr. Mary-Cate Garden (our Heritage Consultant) is carrying this file. A major difficulty is that jurisdiction over cemeteries and burial grounds is divided between the new Bereavement Authority of Ontario and a Registrar in the Ministry of Government Services, while the archaeologists are regulated by the Ministry of Tourism.
