**William Cavanaugh**

William Cavanaugh is a professor at DePaul University in Chicago. He received a B.A. in theology from Notre Dame in 1984, and an M.A. from Cambridge University in 1987. After working as a lay associate with the Holy Cross order in a poor area of Santiago, Chile, he then worked at the Center for Civil and Human Rights at the Notre Dame Law School.

Professor Cavanaugh studied at Duke University, where he received a Ph.D. in religion in 1996 and then taught at the University of St. Thomas since 1995 and at DePaul University starting in 2010. His areas of specialization are in political theology, economic ethics, and ecclesiology.

Cavanaugh's written work has included *Migrations of the Holy: Theologies of State and Church* (2011); *The Myth of Religious Violence: Secular Ideology and the Roots of Modern Conflict* (2009); *Being Consumed: Economics and Christian Desire* (2008); *Torture and Eucharist: Theology, Politics, and the Body of Christ* (1998)
